INTRODUCTION

The purpose of education is well embodied in the upanishad's shloka "तमसो माँ ज्योर्तिगमय" which means lead us from darkness to light. With this aim Shri Hari Public School had been started in year 2000 by renowned social worker Shri Jagdish Chouksey and since then it has been heading towards its goal successfully.

The longest journey begins with the simple first step, From a humble beginning with few students, the school has now flourished with hundreds of students who are the future of tomorrow and are the backbone of our society.

The process of education should includate in the minds and hearts of little ones a deeply convinced desire to create a society with a human face. Such education should be made compulsory & easily available to everyone without any exception based on any sort of discrimination.

Our school aims at this because "Service to mankind is service to god."

SCHOOL RULES - GENERAL

- 1. Students are required to bring their almanac to the School every day.
- 2. Students who come to the School on their own should reach the School at least 15 minutes prior to the first bell.
- 3. Students are required to go to the Assembly ground as soon as the bell rings for the Assembly.
- Students should always be neatly dressed, with their shoes polished and hair combing done properly. They should come to the School in a complete set of uniforms daily.
- 4. Students should always be neatly dressed, with their shoes polished and hair combing done properly. They should come in complete School uniform daily.
- 5. Students who will arrive late and improperly or shabbily dressed will be sent back home.
- 6. Students are advised to make use of the dust-bins provided for throwing bits of paper etc. They are expected to keep the campus neat and clean.
- 7. No student should shout or whistle in the school premises.
- 8. Students must take care of the School property. Damaging school furniture, writing on the walls or disfiguring school property will be dealt with in a strict way and their parents will be called by the Principal.
- 9. Students are advised not to bring costly articles to the School. Any loss of articles or money should be reported to the class or subject teacher immediately. The school shall not be responsible for such losses.
- 10. Students are advised to deposit the articles found in the school with their class teacher.
- 11. Students are required to keep their bicycles duly locked at the cycle-stand. No students of any class will be allowed to come to school by any vehicle.
- 12. Students are not allowed to use office telephone without the permission of the officer in charge.
- 13. Students will not be permitted to attend telephone calls during their class periods until these are very urgent.
- 14. Students are not permitted to carry mobile phones, CDs, floppies, pen drives or any such secondary storage device to the school.
- 15. Parents and guardians are not permitted to visit the class rooms or visit their children or take away their children during the School hours without the written permission of the Principal.
- 16. No ornaments / jewellery will be allowed for the students except the small earrings. In case of any loss of valuables, the school shall not be responsible.

- 17. There should be someone to pick up the child at the bus stop, else the child will be brought back to the school. In that case parents should come to the school with written consent to bring back the child. This will be strictly followed.
- 18. School shall not be responsible for any kind of inconvenience to those students who come by their own conveyance.
- 19. If the tuition fee is not paid on due dates, fine @ Rs. 500 (10th of every month) will be charged. If cheque is dishonored, bank charges will be recovered along with the late fee in cash.
- 21. School fees will be accepted through cheques /cash/draft/online transactions.
- 22. Parents are not allowed to meet the teachers directly without prior appointment/(permission) from the principal during a normal working day.
- 23. It is mandatory for the parents to attend Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM) whenever called for. Parents are advised to keep the school informed of any change in postal address or change in phone numbers in writing because it plays a vital role in case of any emergency.
- 24. Kindly note that organizing tours, picnics or any outing is a part of education in school, but sending your child for it is optional and at your own risk. The school will not be responsible for any mishappening.
- 25. The school's management reserves the right to change, amend, add or delete any of the above mentioned rules and regulations, at any time without prior notice.
- 26. If parents want to meet principal/management the timing will be 11.00 to 1.00 closing normal working days.

MINIMUM ATTENDANCE NECESSARY FOR ANNUAL EXAMINATION

Student may not be allowed to sit in the annual Examination if he/she has not put in a minimum of 75% of the total attendance of the academic session, including attendance in previous school if the student is admitted on transfer.

General Guidelines to the Parents / Guardians and Students

- 1. All the students are expected to come to the school daily in fresh laundered uniform with clean socks and well-polished shoes. Any student found in school in a slovenly condition, shall be sent back home from the class.
- 2. If the parents want to bring back the child from the school, they must take written permission from the Principal.
- 3. No student will be allowed to go home though any unknown person unless he/she brings an authorization letter by the parents and the confirmation on the phone call.
- 4. No student is allowed to leave the school premises without the permission of the Admin staff / Principal.
- 5. Parents/Guardians or any other visitors are strictly forbidden to see the children or meet the teachers during the school/lecture hours without the prior permission from the Principal.
- 6. The communication medium of instructions to the children shall be in English, In the school campus students shall speak in English with each other.
- 7. Students suffering from any contagious disease will not be allowed to the class, separate arrangements could be done for exams.
- 8. Admission will be granted with T.C. from the previous school.
- 9. All students when admitted must make themselves acquainted with the guidelines notified for their conduct while studying in this school. Ignorance of the guidelines will not be excused.
- Students should follow the discipline and should never be noisy, especially when passing through from the class rooms, lobby, office or staffroom.

- 11. Entire class would be responsible for any kind of damage to school property.
- 12. In school, there is a lot of emphasis on personal / general cleanliness and courtesy conversation, misuse of ink by any children, littering, writing on the school table or walls, stealing or hiding someone else's belongings and causing any kind of harm to their classmates will not be spared under any circumstances and those students will not be spared. Strict action will be taken against them.
- 13. If anything like books, money etc. is lost or stolen from the children, then the school will not be responsible for that.
- 14. At times the school may have been closed due to unavoidable and unforeseen reasons. The concerned test or examination will be held on the first working day as per the declared schedule.
- 15. Strict action will be taken by the concerned committee if any student is caught copying/cheating during the examination.
- 16. First Aid will be given to students in case of any emergency or accident during school hours if required they will be taken to the nearest hospital. Parents will be informed immediately.
- 17. Students are strictly prohibited from bringing / eating chewing gums or any kind of pan masala.
- 18. Use of mobile phones or bringing any electronic devices in school are strictly prohibited.

LABORATORY

Students will be bound by the rules which are put up in each laboratory. Any damage or breakage done to the apparatus or equipment has to be replaced or compensated by the students.
